OCTOBER 20<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022

Dear Pumpkin Carver:

This year, The Great Pumpkin Carve, a Chadds Ford tradition, is scheduled **Thursday, October 20<sup>th</sup> and Friday, October 21<sup>st</sup> from 4 – 9 p.m. and Saturday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> from 3 – 9 p.m.**, rain or shine. In case of seriously inclement weather, a decision will be made about any one of the three nights. The actual carving will take place on **Thursday, October 20<sup>th</sup> at 3 p.m.** We're looking for your participation!

**PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING RULES CAREFULLY.** CFHS reserves the right to amend these rules at any time with notification to registered carvers. To qualify for the award categories, the participating pumpkin and carver **must comply** with the contest's general **guidelines** as follows:

1. **Mail in this form with payment of \$30.00 per pumpkin registration. Pumpkins are assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis**, and there are a limited number of pumpkins. Additional carvers are put on a waiting list to replace registered carvers who don't show the day of the Carve. **Numbers are assigned and no changes are allowed.**
2. **NO VEHICLES IN THE PUMPKIN PATCH or CHADDS FORD HISTORICAL SOCIETY GROUNDS.** Please be prepared to transport all necessary tools from the meadow parking lot by foot or some other way – BRING A WHEELBARROW, WAGON OR some other non-mechanized form of transport. ***The meadow parking lot opens at 2:45pm - NO EARLIER.***
3. **Carver check-in is on Thursday, October 20<sup>th</sup> starting at 3:00 p.m. - NO EARLIER.** Once checked in, you can go right to your pumpkin and start carving.
4. **BRING YOUR OWN CANDLES for Thursday night lighting.** The Historical Society will replenish candles for the second and third nights, but it is your responsibility to illuminate your pumpkin the first night for judging consideration.
5. **NO designs or creations pertaining to Politics. NO EXCEPTIONS**
6. **PLEASE DO NOT RELOCATE/REARRANGE** pumpkins or straw bales. Pumpkins and straw bales **MUST** be in their original position and location when your carving is complete.
7. **The Chadds Ford Historical Society reserves the right to remove pumpkin carvings that it deems offensive and/or inappropriate for a family event.** The decision to remove a pumpkin is at the sole discretion of the Chadds Ford Historical Society. All decisions are final. No refunds will be given for pumpkins removed from display.
8. If a carver is **not carving** their pumpkin **by 5:00 p.m.**, without notice that they are running late, that pumpkin will be **forfeited** to a carver on the waiting list.
9. Carving MUST be completed by 8 p.m. on Thursday night to be eligible for judging. Winners will be posted on the Chadds Ford Historical Society website on Friday, October 21st.

10. **FOUR Carvers per pumpkin**, NO EXCEPTIONS. Carvers' ages 12 - 16 years old MUST be accompanied by an adult. **Registration payment of \$30 is per pumpkin, not per carver.** Send in the below registration form with a check made payable to CFHS (Chadds Ford Historical Society).
11. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** are permitted before or while carving for safety of you and other carvers.
12. **NO DOGS ALLOWED** at the event. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
13. The use of power tools of any kind, and/or the use of lighting other than lit candles will disqualify you from all prize categories except the People's Choice Award.
14. After several requests from carvers, we are allowing the use of additional materials as design elements, including props such as small pumpkins, squash, glitter, etc. No posts or poles.
15. If you want to pick up your carved pumpkin **AFTER** the 3-day event, please email us at [CFPumpkinCarve@gmail.com](mailto:CFPumpkinCarve@gmail.com) by the end of the day, Friday, October 21<sup>st</sup> to be on the list. Carvers can pick up their pumpkin(s) at the end of the event, **Saturday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>, between 9:00p.m. – 9:30p.m.** Carved Pumpkins are composted **EARLY** Sunday morning, October 23<sup>rd</sup>, so carvers must arrange pick up for Saturday night.

*Please Note:* your registration must be received in the office by Friday, **October 7<sup>th</sup>**, the sooner, the better. Once received, we will email a confirmation to you with your Pumpkin #. See you on the 20<sup>th</sup>!

## Prize Categories

A panel of three judges will determine the winners and honorable mentions in the following categories:

*Best Overall, Most Traditional Halloween, and Best Use of Pumpkin.*

### **Best Overall**

A clean carving with a high degree of detail, imagination and creativity using cutting, carving, or engraving to achieve outstanding effects in the final design.

Create a new twist on the ol' jack-o-lantern or come up with a pumpkin that will be sure to stand out in any patch!

### **Most Traditional Halloween**

Includes all traditional Halloween-themed designs, such as jack-o-lanterns, ghosts, goblins, and witches.

### **Best Use of Pumpkin**

Pumpkins that have been carved to their fullest. Qualifying pumpkins will be judged for original size and shape that are incorporated into the final design.

This could include using pieces of the pumpkin to change the shape!

### **People's Choice**

This is chosen by the spectators during all three nights of the Great Pumpkin Carve.

Visitors can vote for their favorite pumpkin in person, with the winner being announced on the Monday after the event.
