Hank's Place Restaurant to Help Chadds Ford Historical Society

(Chadds Ford, PA) – The popular Chadds Ford restaurant Hank's Place will hold a benefit for the Chadds Ford Historical Society on Sunday, January 23, 2005, from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Restaurant owners Peter and Voula Skiadas will donate \$1,000 of the day's proceeds to the Historical Society – an annual tradition the Skiadas' began 13 years ago as a gesture of neighborly support. The gray clapboard restaurant is located on the corner of Route 1 and Creek Road.

Historical Society volunteers will be on hand at the event to answer questions about Chadds Ford's history and the Society's activities. Customers who come in for lunch or brunch will benefit two of Chadds Ford's best known institutions. Hank's Place is a favorite with local residents who love the friendly atmosphere and delicious home-style cooking. Breakfast specialties are served all day and include John Chads' apple pancakes, Hank's Eggs Benedict, creamed chipped beef over toast and a shiitake mushroom omelet. Soups, sandwiches and Greek dishes are also featured.

The Chadds Ford Historical Society is the sponsor of popular events such as Pumpkin Carve, Chadds Ford Days and Candlelight Christmas. Funds from these events support history programs for schoolchildren at its two house-museums, the John Chads House and the Barns-Brinton House. The Society's Headquarters is in the Barn Visitors Center on Creek Road, ¼ mile north of Route 1.
